COVID-19 - Ease of restrictive measures announced by the Republic of Cyprus

The Council of Ministers has decided on the 3rd of June 2020 to proceed with the further ease of COVID-19 related restrictions, taking into account the positive epidemiological picture prevailing in Cyprus, as per the Scientific Committee's input.

As announced by the the Minister of Health, Konstantinos Ioannou, the Council of Ministers has decided the following:

- As from the 5th of June Swimming pools will reopen
- As from the 9th of June the following will recommence operations:
 - Malls, Airports, Ports, Indoor catering services, Open-air theatres, Open-air cinemas, Sports championships/tournaments without spectators, Kindergartens, Nurseries, Children's clubs, Outdoor children's playgrounds, All-day schools, Summer schools
- As from the 13th of June the following will be allowed to recommence operations:
 - Casinos, Dance schools, Sports schools, Gyms and thematic parks
- As from the 24th of June the limitation of 10 persons per gathering will be lifted.

The above ease of measures is subject to the epidemiological picture of Cyprus. The Government will closely monitor and amend the restrictive measures accordingly.
